

Paracetamol Induced Fixed Drug Eruption- A Relatively Rare Case Report

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Abstract

A 40 years old male patient reported with multiple ulcerative lesions over oral mucosa and glance penis since last 1 day. He has taken tablet Paracetamol 500mg twice daily for one day for the management of fever. On physical examination, multiple ulcerative lesions over oral mucosa and glance penis were observed. Patient was hospitalized, symptomatically treated and Paracetamol was withdrawn. Patient recovered.
